 - modacrylic/Lenzing FR inner lining
- Colour: Navy Blue, other colours optional
- Sizes: medium, large and extra large

Application

Approved as personal protective equipment for fire-fighter's outfit complying with the provisions of the Fire Safety Systems Code. The two-piece garment composed by a jacket and trousers, both must be worn together and must be used in combination with MED approved boots, gloves and helmet together to provide the required protection. 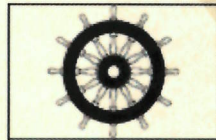


